Requirements:

- [] Completed and signed scholarship application

- [] Letter to the scholarship committee; no longer than 2 pages, detailing your career/credits as an artist that explains how these experiences have affected your life, what the arts have taught you, and how you plan to incorporate the arts into your long-range goals.
- [] Two letters of recommendation. One from someone involved in your education. One from someone from an extracurricular/community activity.

Selection Criteria

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of: Academic achievement, Extra-curricular activities, as well as Community Service and Involvement. Determination will be made strictly on the merit of the applicant's performance against the above criteria. The selection and award of scholarships is a nondiscriminatory process. The scholarship may be renewable at a lower monetary amount than the initial award, subject to satisfactory progress.
